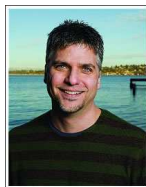

Director's Corner

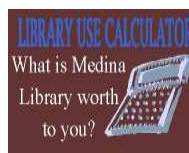

I spend a lot of time at home keeping up with family and friends via Facebook, Skype, e-mail, chat, etc. It follows, then, that I encourage the library staff to utilize computer technology to reach out to our library patrons. So if you, like me, enjoy using your computer take some time to become a "fan" of Lee-Whedon Memorial Library through Facebook. Once you become a fan you will receive "invitations" to library events in advance, can view pictures from recent events and make comments about how you feel we're doing at Lee-Whedon. We've had a terrific website for a number of years that is not as interactive as Facebook but there is an incredible amount of information there to check out. From our websites you can access a 24 hour/seven day a week chat reference service provided free of charge with the use of your library card. You can calculate the value of your library using a scoring system based on how many books you've checked out, how many times you've used our in-house computers, or attended a library program; I think you'll be surprised how much the library saves you every time you use your library card. There is also a page to use to make memorial donations if you're unable to come into the library you simply fill out the form online and mail it to us with your contribution; we've not gotten as high tech as being able to accept credit and debit cards yet. Our website also provides access to downloadable audio books,



children's games and websites, lists of new books and media purchased by the library in addition to links to other local organizations. If you're not making it to the library in person these days please take some time to visit through the internet, I know you'll be glad you did!

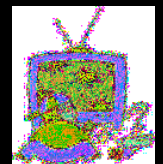
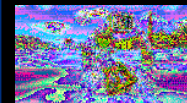
