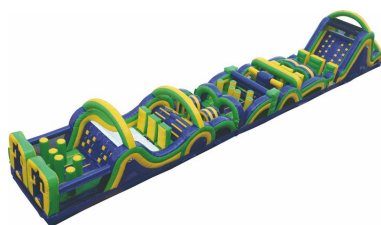
One of our patrons won 2nd place in the Check Out Challenge. Congratulations Lucas! Thank you to everyone who participated.
