PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Education of the Medina Central School District, Orleans, Niagara and Genesee Counties, New York (the "District"), has scheduled a special meeting of the qualified voters of said District to be held in the District Office Boardroom, One Mustang Drive, Medina, New York 14103, on December 10, 2024, or in the event of a weather or other emergency which necessitates the cancellation of the December 10, 2024 meeting, on December 17, 2024, with polls to be open between the hours of 12:00 p.m. (noon) and 8:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting upon the following Library Bond Proposition:

## LIBRARY BOND PROPOSITION NO. 1

SHALL the Board of Trustees of the Lee-Whedon Memorial Public Library (the "Library") be hereby authorized to undertake the construction of an approximately 4,785 square-foot addition to the Lee-Whedon Memorial Library, located at 620 West Avenue, Medina, New York 14103, including site improvements and a secondary parking lot and all related incidental and ancillary improvements, costs and expenses in connection thereto; all at a total estimated maximum cost not to exceed \$5,200,000, with such cost being raised by a tax to be levied and collected in annual installments in such amounts and in such years as may be determined by the Board of Education of the District, with such tax to be potentially partially offset by any New York State or federal grants or Library monies available therefore, and in anticipation of such tax, by obligations of said District as may be necessary?

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots for voting on the above-referenced proposition may be applied for at the office of the District Clerk, One Mustang Drive, Medina, New York 14103. Any such application must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the date of the vote on the above-referenced proposition, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before such vote, if the ballot is to be picked up personally by the voter. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available for public inspection during regular business hours in the office of the District Clerk on each of the five (5) days prior to the day of the election except Sunday. Absentee ballots must be received in the office of the District Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. on December 10, 2024.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that applications for early mail ballots for voting on the above-referenced proposition may be applied for at the office of the District Clerk, One Mustang Drive, Medina, New York 14103. Applications must be received at least seven (7) days prior to the election if the early mail ballot is to be mailed to the voter (December 3, 2024) or the day before the election (December 9, 2024), if the ballot is to be issued in person to the voter. A list of all persons to whom early ballots shall have been issued will be available for public inspection during regular business hours in the office of the District Clerk on each of the five (5) days prior to the day of the election except Sunday during regular office hours until the day of the election. Early ballots must be received in the office of the District Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. local time on December 10, 2024; and

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that military voters who are defined by Commissioner's Regulation Part 11, who are qualified voters as of the District may apply for a military ballot during normal business hours or by requesting an application from the Office of the District Clerk, One Mustang Drive, Medina, New York 14103. In a request for a military ballot application/military ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application/military ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail. Completed applications for military ballots must be received by the Office of the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 14, 2024. Ballots for military voters shall be mailed, or otherwise distributed, no later than twenty-five (25) days prior to the date of the vote. As such, all military ballots must be received in the Office of the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. local time on December 10, 2024.
